

Electronics Recycling



Computers, televisions and other electronic equipment can contain lead, mercury, cadmium and other toxic materials, which should be disposed of properly. These items also contain valuable metals such as gold, silver and palladium that can be recycled through special programs.

Alpha Ridge Landfill accepts:

- Computer processors and accessories (please no speakers)
- Laptop computers
- Monitors
- Keyboards
- Printers
- Scanners
- TVs
- VCR/DVD players
- Radios/Stereos (please no speakers)
- CD Players
- Phones, cell phones, pagers
- Holiday strands of lights
- any other items with a circuit board

Residents are required to show their driver's licenses as proof of residence in Howard County. Howard County businesses can bring electronics to the Alpha Ridge Landfill (maximum of 10 items per day). Businesses are limited to 2 TVs or monitors per day.
