

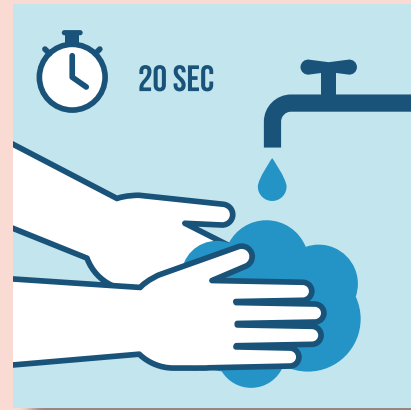

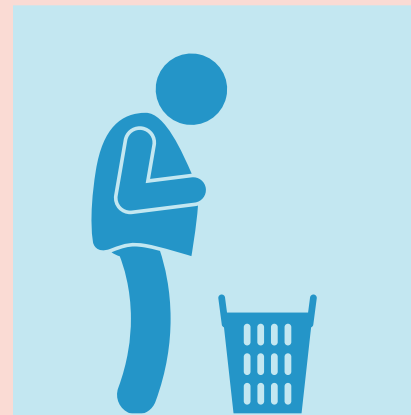
At Home



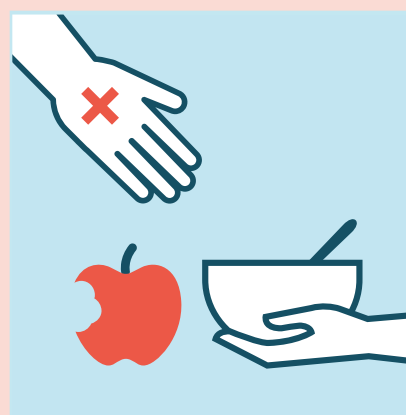
Wash Your Hands Frequently

Change clothes when you come in from work.

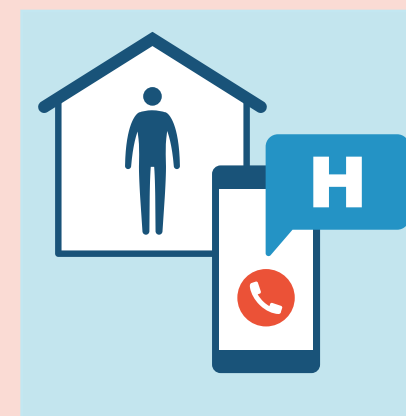


Don't share cooking/eating utensils

If you have been exposed to COVID-19

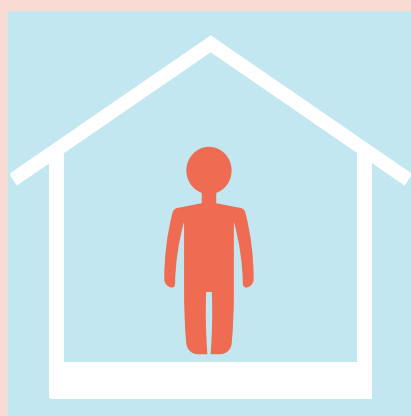


Take your temperature and monitor for any symptoms

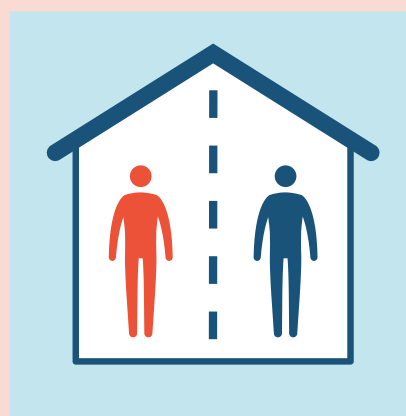


If you have any symptoms, contact your healthcare provider or the Health Department

Do not go to work

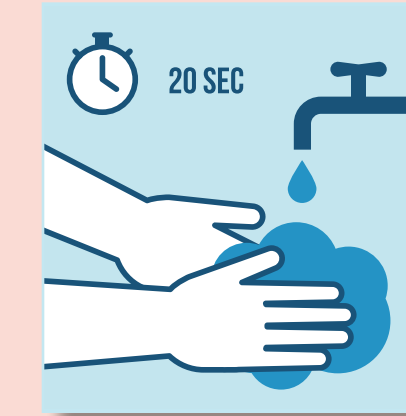


Stay in a separate room from others, if possible

At Work



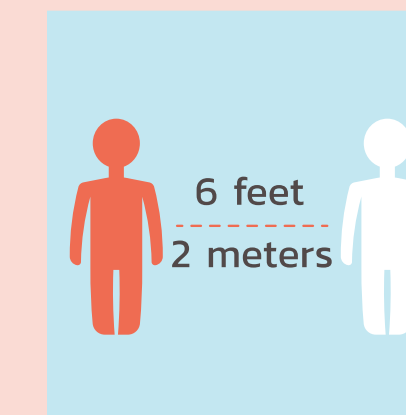
Wear a Mask/ Facecovering over your nose and mouth



Wash Your Hands Frequently

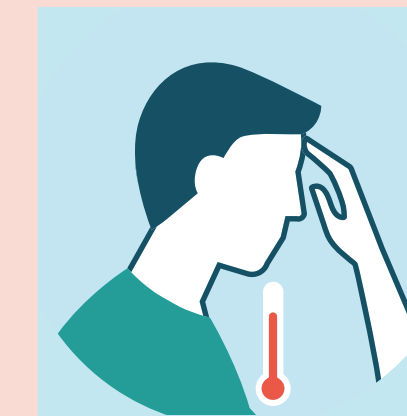


Don't Share Tools/Utensils

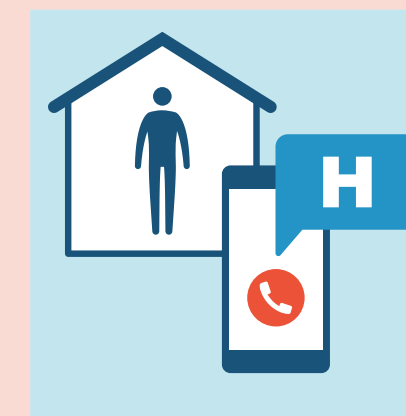


Stay 6 feet apart, if possible
