Websites. Our websites have been created to provide the public with current, relevant, and comprehensive information, including:

- Howard County Office of Transportation, including its 2020 Transportation Town Hall and many project specific webpages.
- <u>Howard County's Complete Streets</u>, which includes information on the County policy, implementation, community engagement plan, and related resources.
- <u>Howard County's BikeHoward</u> which provides information on the County's bicycle master plan that was adopted in April 2016. The site also hosts information on previous year's <u>BikeHoward Open Houses</u> (Our *BikeHoward* Open Houses have been replaced by this year's Active Transportation Open House).
- <u>Howard County's WalkHoward</u> which addresses the County's pedestrian master plan that was adopted in February 2020.
- <u>Howard County Portal of Services</u> was created for residents to easily access disaster and emergency resources, such as rent relief, food distribution, and other essential services, including transportation.
- <u>HoCo Dash</u> showcases performance objectives that reflect the County Executive's top priorities for Howard County. It includes data sets, objectives, targets and strategies that will assist in improving the quality of life for its residents and businesses.
- <u>Go Howard</u> hosts the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program of Howard County funded by the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration, and the Howard County Office of Transportation.
- Regional Transportation Agency of Central Maryland (RTA) is the public transportation service providing fixed route and paratransit services within Howard County, Anne Arundel County, Northern Prince George's County and the City of Laurel.
- <u>Baltimore Regional Transportation Board</u> (BRTB) is the region's metropolitan planning organization. Several ways to engage are provided on their <u>Getting Involved webpage</u>.
