







Way Station Inc. **In-Home Services Program Fact Sheet for Parents**

The In-Home Services Program is designed to provide in-home intervention and support to help families manage their current situation in a way that keeps them together. Additionally, the Program seeks to teach the families new skills and/or set up services that will maximize the families' strengths to ensure that they remain together on a long-term basis. A Senior Family Services Worker works with the family between 3- 6 months to identify family-based goals and maintain long-term changes. The SFSW maintains a minimum of one contact with each family per week for the duration of the program.

There is no service fee to utilize this program. In order to qualify, the identified child should be receiving Medical Assistance (exceptions can be made through the Howard County Health Department Bureau of Behavioral Health for children who have private insurance).
