The Board expressed support for the requested amendment, noting that an indoor facility would have much less impact upon other properties than an outdoor facility. The Board was supportive of the fact that it it would be a Conditional Use subject to review by the Hearing Examiner on a case by case basis. The Board found it odd that although outdoor athletic facilities have been allowed as a Conditional Use category in the western part of the County for many years, indoor athletic facilities have not been allowed. Mr. Engelke made the motion to recommend approval of the petition in accordance with the DPZ recommendation and revisions. Ms. Easley seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5 to 0.

For the foregoing reasons, the Planning Board of Howard County, Maryland, on this 18th day of August, 2016, recommends that ZRA-165 as described above, be APPROVED, with the revisions recommended by DPZ.
