Subject: Rescinding and Restating the Award of Points under the Length of Service Award Program for Volunteer

firefighters/EMS personnel

WHEREAS, Section 17.103(h) of the County Code provides the Length of Service Award Program (LOSAP) to recognize volunteer fire fighter/EMS personnel in their extensive volunteer service to the citizens of Howard County; and

WHEREAS, to receive credit for a year of active service, a Volunteer must have accumulated at least 50 creditable points during the year that runs from January 1 through December 31 and points are not transferrable from one year to the next; and

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 global pandemic, Howard County limited access to all fire and rescue stations located in the County to operational emergency personnel only; and

WHEREAS, the closure of County fire and rescue stations to all but operational personnel limited the ability of Volunteer Fire Corporations recognized in County Code section 17.103(a) to engage in activities that would enable their members to earn points under LOSAP, because administrative duties, public outreach activities, social gatherings hosted in the facilities, and fundraising capabilities were limited; and

WHEREAS, County Volunteer Fire Corporations and their members continue to provide a valuable service to the community during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, County Code Section 17.103(h)(9)(vii), as codified by Council Bill No. 46-2020 (effective December 7, 2020), provides that the County Executive may, by Executive Order, award LOSAP points because of a State of Emergency declared by the Federal Government, State of Maryland, or the Howard County Government; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of County Code Section 17.103(h)(9)(vii) exist because the State of Maryland and Howard County have both declared a State of Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, which continue as of the date of this Executive Order and for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, by the issuance of Executive Order 2020-21, the County Executive awarded

points pursuant to Section 17.103(h)(9)(vii); and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2020-21 needs to be rescinded and reissued in order to clarify who is entitled to be granted LOSAP points.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND PROCLAIMED by the County Executive of Howard County, Maryland, that Executive Order No. 2020-21 is hereby rescinded and, for calendar year 2020, the six recognized Volunteer Fire Corporations (as listed in Section 17.103(a)(1-6) of the Howard County Code) may award up to 18.9 LOSAP points to all members who would otherwise have been awarded LOSAP points for carrying out the volunteer activities listed in 17.103(h)(9)(v) of the Howard County Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that:

- (1) This Executive Order shall be promptly publicized; and
- (2) A copy filed with the Administrator to the County Council of Howard County.
