- 1 (a) (1) In Charles County and Washington County, the County Commissioners 2 may adopt ordinances or regulations relating to massage establishments and the practices 3 of massage therapists, massage practitioners, and any other individuals who provide 4 massage for compensation.
- 5 (2) IN HOWARD COUNTY, THE GOVERNING BODY MAY ADOPT
  6 ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS RELATING TO MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENTS AND THE
  7 PRACTICES OF MASSAGE THERAPISTS, MASSAGE PRACTITIONERS, AND ANY OTHER
