#### **Howard County Residential Building Permits – 1991 to 2002**

#### Introduction

Since 1991, the Department of Planning and Zoning (DPZ) has maintained a building permit database based on daily information received from the Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits. This information is used to maintain DPZ's land use database as well as to publish DPZ's monthly Construction Report and annual Development Monitoring System report.

Recently, in order to assist the Howard County Public School System with student enrollment projections, residential building permits were geocoded to street addresses. *This current Research Report graphically depicts in map format the geocoded building permits on an annual basis over the 1991 through 2002 time period. Results are shown by Planning Area.* Annual maps as well as a larger summary map for each Planning Area depicting major subdivisions are included.

Note that given the large file size of this document, which has been converted to Adobe Acrobat format for viewing over the internet, it has been broken up into five additional sections, one for each Planning Area, to avoid cumbersome download times. Click on the appropriate link on the web page for each section.

#### Summary

From 1991 through 2002, 21,831 residential structures have been built in the County. These have been geocoded and mapped and are shown on the following pages with a single dot representing each structure. (Note that for purposes of this analysis, apartment buildings are considered a structure. Including individual apartment *units*, there were actually 24,136 building permits issued during the 12 year time period, an average of about 2,000 units per year. For further details on unit counts by unit type and location, please refer to DPZ's Development Monitoring System Report.)


The table and chart below summarize the data by Planning Area for each year. Over the twelve year period, Columbia has had the most residential structures built (5,822), followed by Ellicott City (4,674) and then Elkridge (4,667). The Rural West has had 3,884 new structures built and

the Southeast 2,784 new structures. The maps on the subsequent pages show these developments over time, clearly depicting development patterns and unit concentrations.










































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






































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






































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































# Southeast Planning Area Building Permits 1991 to 2002
