2000 CENSUS Characteristics of Columbia, MD

Introduction

This report summarizes the 100 percent count data from the 2000 Census for the 10 villages in Columbia. Information on population, race, age, household type and relationships, and housing unit tenure and vacancies are included. For most of these data categories comparisons by village and to Howard County as a whole are conducted and discussed in the sections below.

To derive this information by individual village, an aggregation of Census Blocks that “best fit” each village was derived. Maps in Appendix B located at the end of this report show the Census Blocks used for each village and how they approximate the village boundaries. In some cases, the “match” is close. In other cases, blocks extend beyond the village boundary, but were included given a large portion of the block is contained within the village. Overall, since Census Blocks are the smallest Census geography, these data represent the best approximation of the 2000 Census results by village.¹ In Appendix A at the end of this report are more detailed data summaries for each village based on the Census Block aggregation.²

Population and Race

The tables on Page 3 show the population by race and the total population for each village listed in alphabetical order. Long Reach had the greatest population in 2000 with 16,949 residents, almost 19 percent of the estimated 89,687 total in Columbia. This is followed by Hickory Ridge with 16.1 percent and King’s Contrivance with 12.3 percent of the total. The smallest village is Town Center with only 1,743 residents, 1.9 percent of the total. River Hill is the second smallest Village with 5,636 residents in 2000, 6.3 percent of the total.

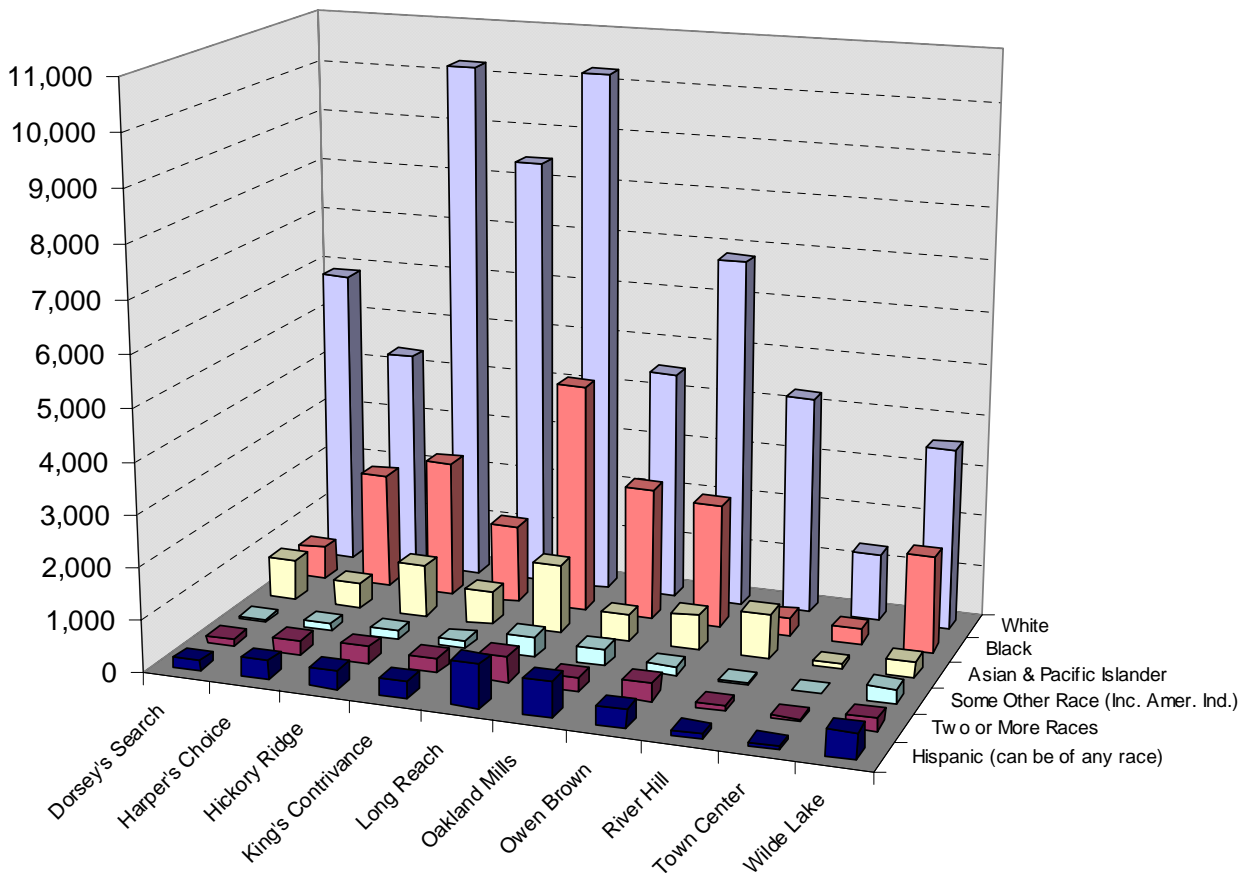

The tables show the racial composition of each village. Overall in Columbia, 66.4 percent of all residents are White, 21.3 percent are Black, 7.6 percent Asian and Pacific Islander, 2.8 percent two or more races, and 1.7 percent some other race. The Hispanic population, which can be of any race, make up 4.2 percent of the population in Columbia.

The second table shows the percent of the total race category shared by each village, whereas the third table shows the race as a percent of the total village population. The percentages in red are those percentages that are more than the percentages for the associated category. For example, 17.2 percent of the total White population in Columbia live in Hickory Ridge. However, 16.1 percent of the total Columbia population live in Hickory Ridge. This results in a slightly higher “propensity” of Whites living in Hickory Ridge compared to Columbia as a whole. The red percentages therefore show the relatively higher concentrations of each race category by village.

It is important to note that these concentrations are relatively low, and all of the Villages have relatively diverse populations. The most diverse villages include Oakland Mills, Wilde Lake and Harper’s Choice with White populations in the 50 percent range and minority populations, primarily Black, making up the remaining percentages. The least diverse villages include Dorsey’s Search, King’s Contrivance, River Hill and Town Center with over 75 percent White residents. Asian residents are relatively concentrated in Long Reach, River Hill and Dorsey’s Search. The chart below summarizes the results graphically for each race by Village.

The table and chart below summarize the population by race in Columbia compared to Howard County.³ Columbia has a more diverse population than Howard County as a whole with only 66.4 percent Whites compared to 74.3 percent Whites in Howard County. Columbia makes up about 36 percent of the total County population, yet over 50 percent of the County's Black, Hispanic and other race population each live in Columbia. The Asian population in Columbia is 35.6 percent of the total County population, about the same as the Columbia's total share.

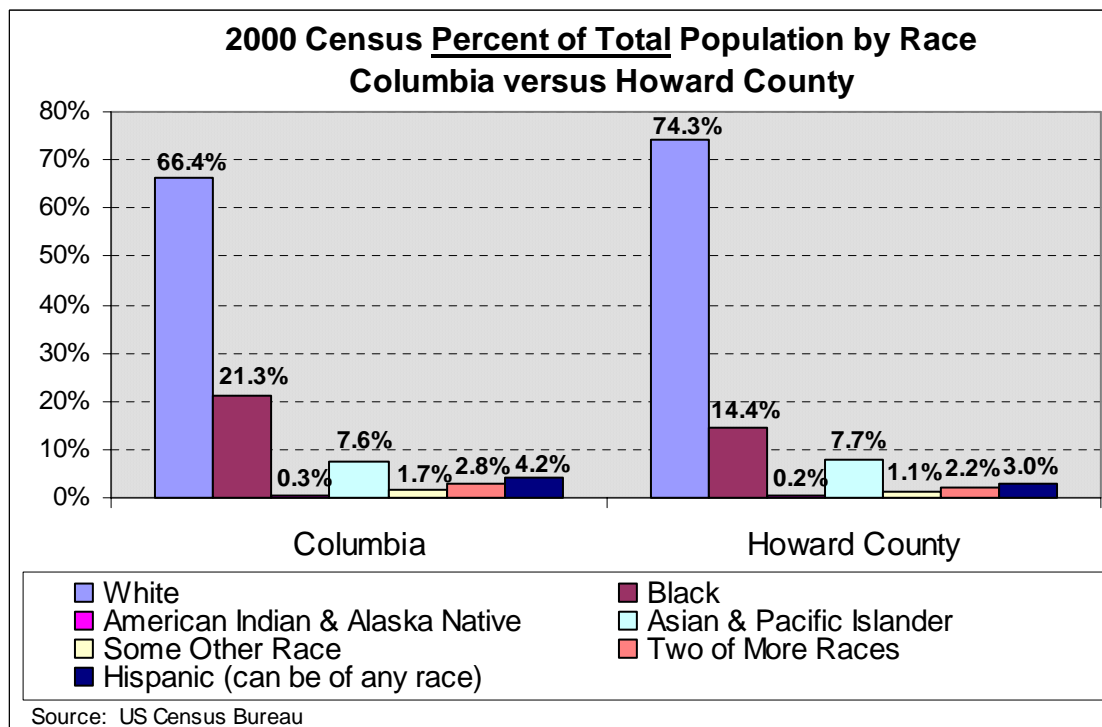

Population by Age

The tables below summarize the population by age in the Columbia Villages as reported by the 2000 Census. For the first table, various age ranges are shown and summary totals are summarized at the bottom. The first chart shows the results graphically followed by tables and a chart showing the results by percentage.

Similar to the percentage tables in the previous section on age, the percentages in red are those percentages that are more than the percentages for the associated category. For example, 11.3 percent of the total population under the age of 5 in Columbia lived in River Hill in 2000. However, only 6.3 percent of the total Columbia population lived in River Hill at that time. This indicates that there is a higher “propensity” of under 5 year olds living in River Hill compared to Columbia as a whole. The red percentages therefore show the relatively higher concentrations of each age category by village.

The following points summarize the age comparison data.

- River Hill, the second smallest village in Columbia in terms of total population, had higher concentrations of children under the age of 5 in 2000 compared to the other Villages. Long Reach also had relatively high numbers. These two villages have new neighborhoods – Kendall Ridge and Pointers Run – that were actively being constructed in the mid to late 1990s. The age data clearly confirm that families with young children tend to move into newly built subdivisions. River Hill also had a relatively high percentage of 5 to 19 year olds and 35 to 44 year olds (their parents) in 2000 compared to Columbia as a whole.
- At the other end of the age spectrum, Town Center and Wilde Lake have higher concentrations of older residents, followed by Harpers Choice and Hickory Ridge. In Town Center the concentrations generally increase as the ages increase. For example, 15 percent of all those 85 and older living in Columbia in 2000 lived in Town Center, although the total population of Town Center represented only 1.9% of the total population in Columbia.
- In terms of absolute numbers, Long Reach had the greatest number of children under the age of five (1,383), followed by Hickory Ridge (820), Owen Brown (743), King’s Contrivance (720) and then River Hill (711). Town Center only had 5 residents under the age of five.
- For those 65 and older the ranking is: Hickory Ridge (1,412), Long Reach (897), Wilde Lake (796), Owen Brown (781) and then Harper’s Choice (578).
- In general, and as would be expected, the older villages had higher concentrations of older residents and the younger villages had greater concentrations of younger residents, although clearly there is a diversity of age throughout Columbia reflecting the normal demographic patterns of our highly mobile society.

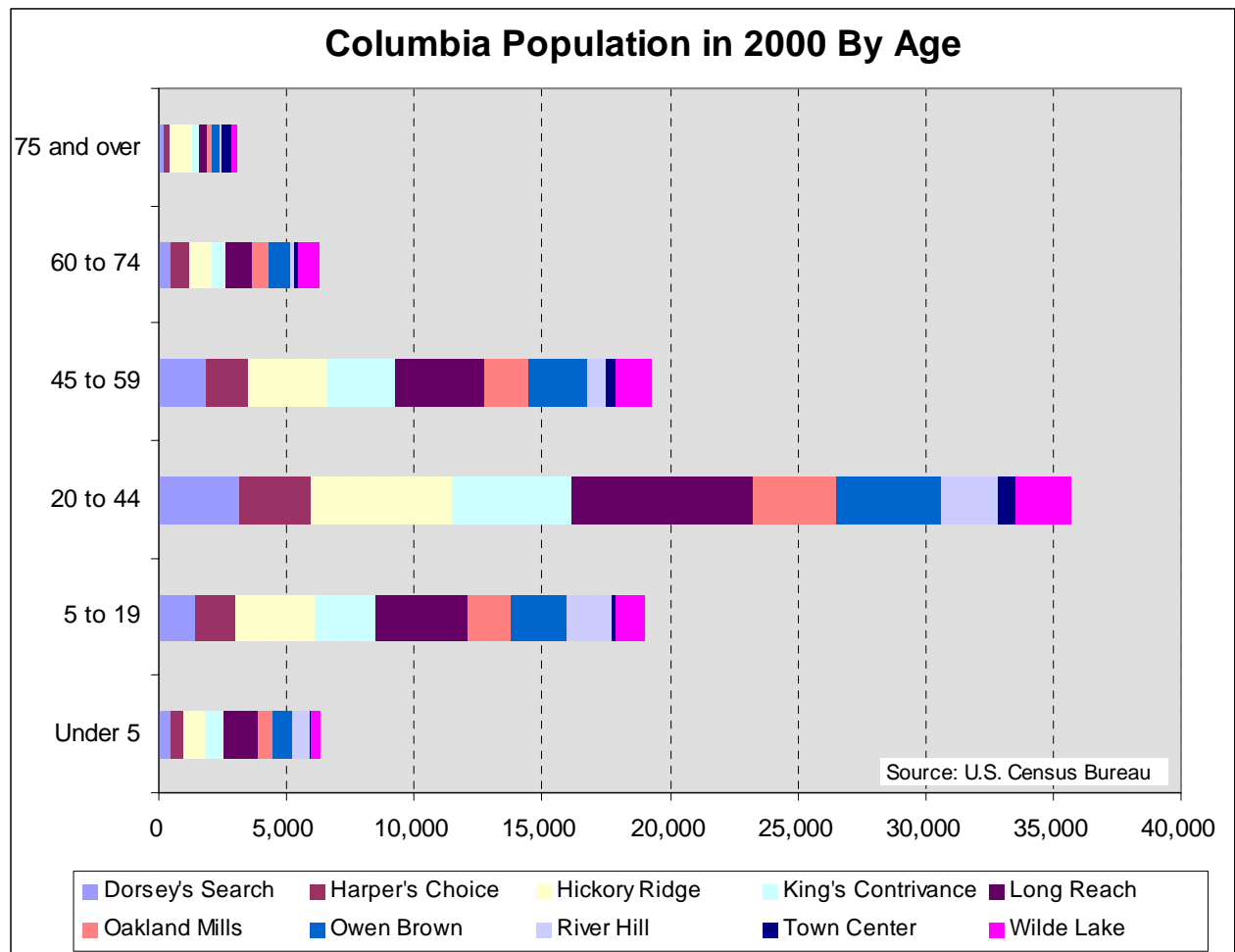

(As Percent of Total Village)**

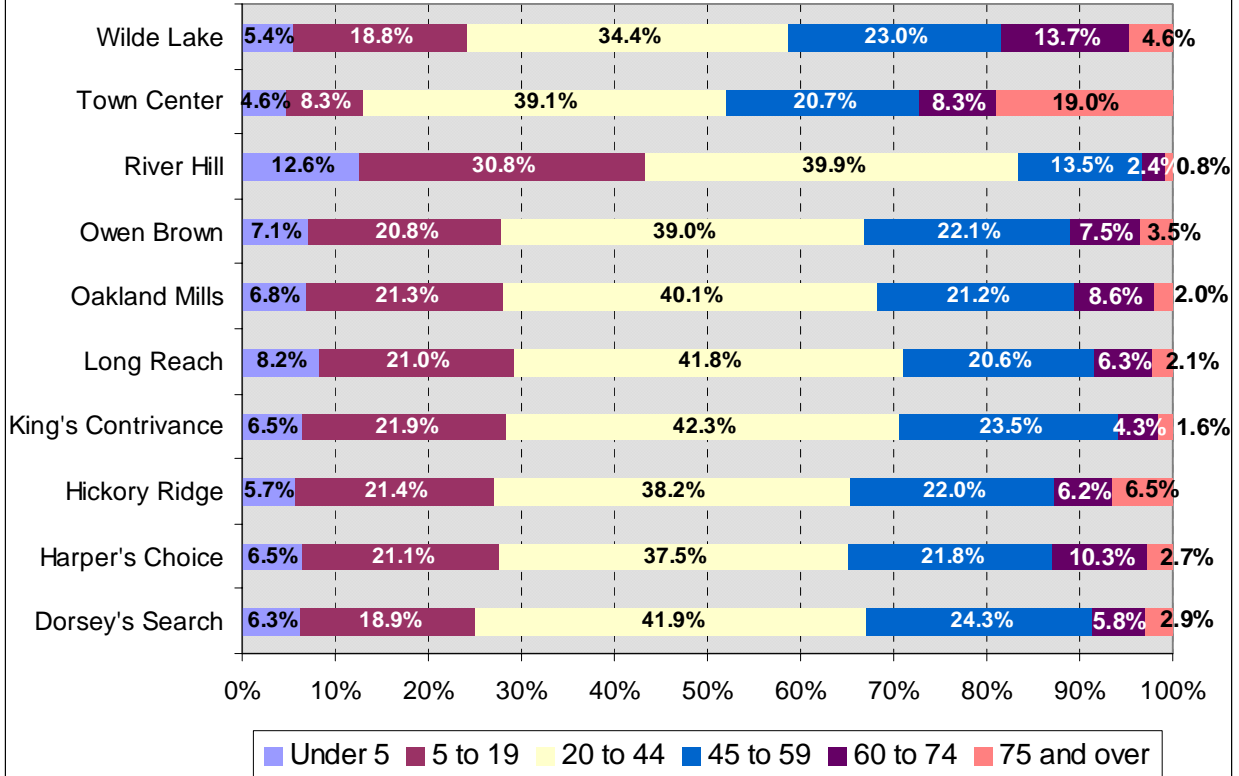

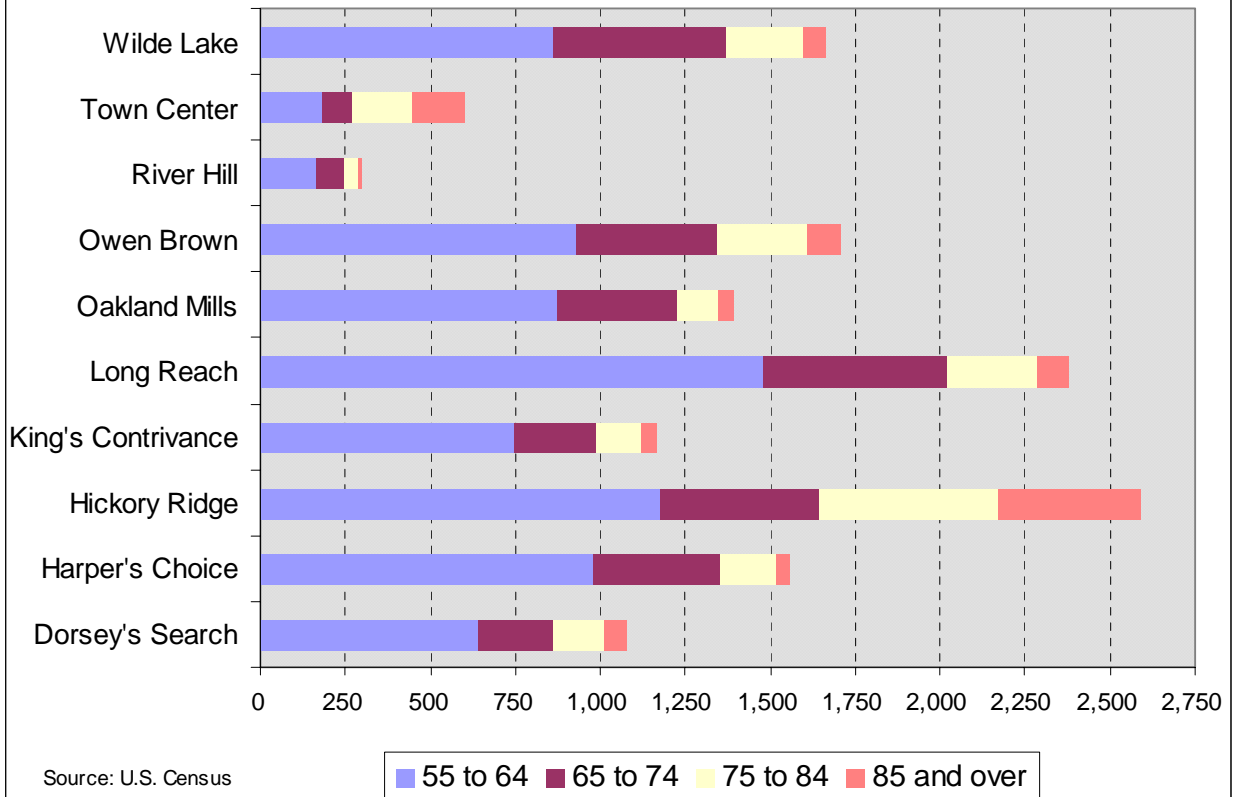

The table below summarizes the population by age in Columbia compared to Howard County as a whole.⁴ In general, the age breakdown in Columbia is similar to that of the County, with the largest cohorts between 25 and 54 years old, which includes the baby boomers. There are only slight variations between the percentages by cohort, indicating that the age breakdown in Columbia, which accounts for a little more than a third of Howard County's population, is reflective of the general age distribution in the County. One cohort that does stand out are the relatively high numbers of residents over 85 in Columbia, which make up almost half of the total in this age group in Howard County.

Household Type and Relationships

The series of tables below indicate household type within Columbia, showing the results by Village. The first table shows the absolute numbers and the next two tables show the percentage breakdowns.

The percentages in red are those percentages that are greater than the total percentage for the associated category. For example, as shown in the third table, more than 95 percent of all households in River Hill are considered family households. This compares to a little over 67 percent being family households in Columbia as a whole, clearly showing the propensity of families in River Hill.⁵ River Hill also has a much higher percentage of married couple families.

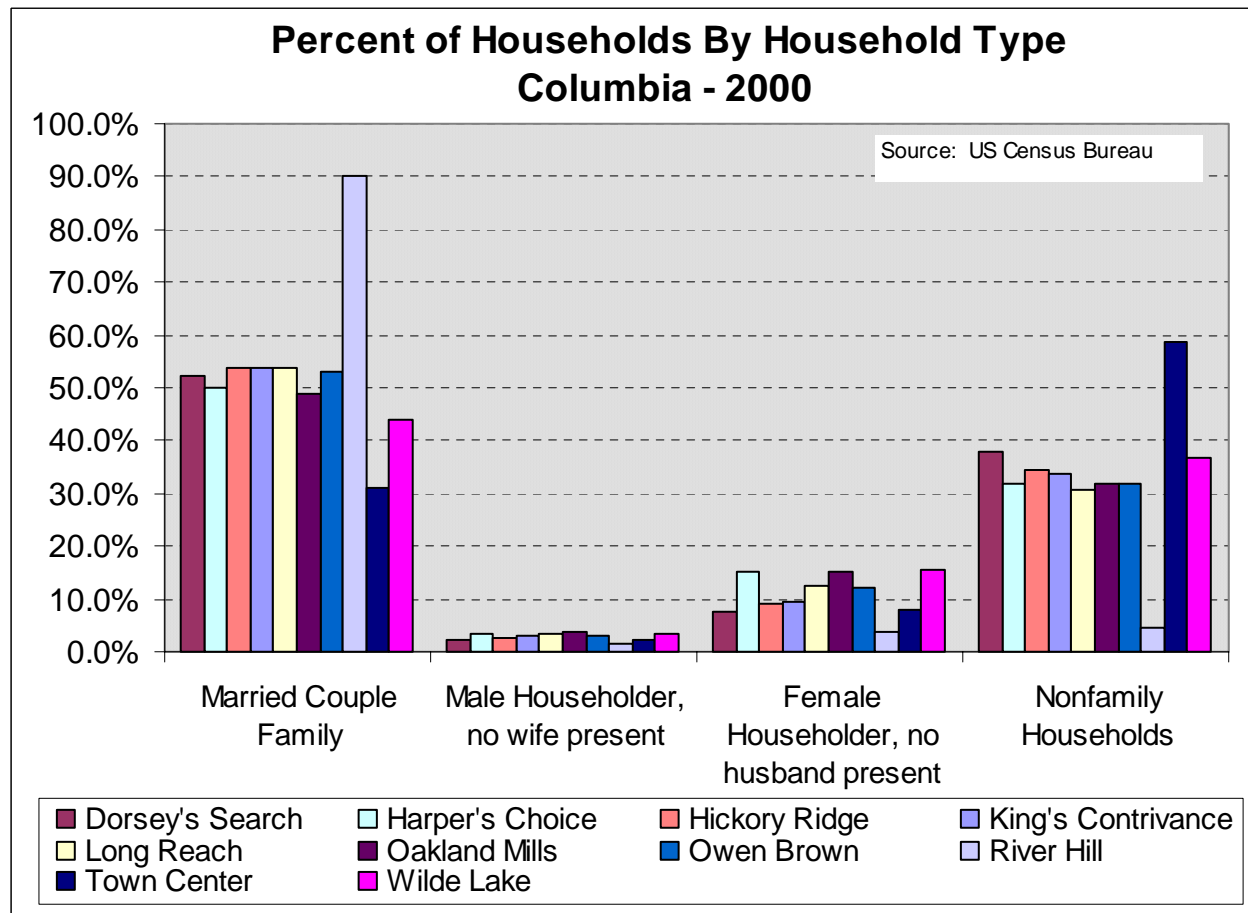

Overall, of the total 34,777 households in Columbia, about two-thirds are family households (23,394) and one-third are non-family households (11,383). In Howard County, the ratio is about three-fourths family households and one-fourth non-family households.⁶ In general, Columbia has a higher proportion of higher density units (townhouses, condos and apartments), naturally leading to more non-families, particular households with residents living alone (see further below).

As indicated earlier, River Hill had a much higher propensity to have family, and in particular married couple families, living there in 2000. The last table on the page above shows this – the villages with the largest percentage in each category are shown in larger bold red text. Wilde Lake has the largest percentage of other family households, 19.1 percent compared to an average of 14.1 percent in all of Columbia. The percentage for Howard County is even smaller at 11.1 percent. Other family households primarily consist of single parent households – mostly single mothers and to a lesser degree single fathers.

Wilde Lake also has the largest percentage of other family households with a female householder and no husband present at 15.7 percent, compared to 11.3 percent in Columbia. For Howard County the percentage is a smaller 8.4 percent. Oakland Mills has the greatest percentage of other family households with a male householder and no wife present – 3.9 percent compared to 3.0 percent in Columbia. In Howard County the percentage is 2.7 percent.

For non-family households, Town Center has the greatest percentage at 58.6 percent, compared to 32.7 percent in Columbia and 25.8 percent in Howard County. The chart on the previous page clearly shows relative magnitude of this percentage in Town Center compared to the other villages. River Hill’s married couple percentage is also very pronounced.

The tables below further breakdown the family households delineating those with and without children for each category. Some highlights include: 1) 77.8 percent of family households in River Hill are married couple families with children under 18, compared to 41.7 percent in Columbia and 44.4 percent in Howard County, and 2) Of the small number of family households in Town Center, 54.8 percent are married without children, compared to 37.1 percent in Columbia and 38.3 percent in Howard County. The tables also show data for single parent households. Refer to the Appendix at the end of this report for statistics on children by age – under 6 versus those 6 to 17.

The tables below summarize the non-family households in Columbia in 2000 including those with householders living alone, which are most of these households, and those not living alone. As indicated earlier, there were 11,383 non-family households in Columbia. Almost 84 percent of these consist of households with residents living alone – 8,977 households. Town Center has the greatest percentage with 88.9 percent, followed by Wilde Lake with 83.7 percent and Harper’s Choice with 78.9 percent. River Hill has the smallest percentages of non-family householders living alone with 70 percent, although this is only out of 70 non-family households total.

The next set of tables and chart shows the percentages based on *total* households, not just non-family households. The 8,977 residents living alone represent a little more than a quarter (25.8 percent) of the 34,777 total households in Columbia. This compares to about a fifth (20.8 percent) of all households in Howard County. The contrast between River Hill and Town Center is clearly apparent, with more than half of all households in Town Center consisting of residents living alone compared to only 3.2 percent in River Hill.

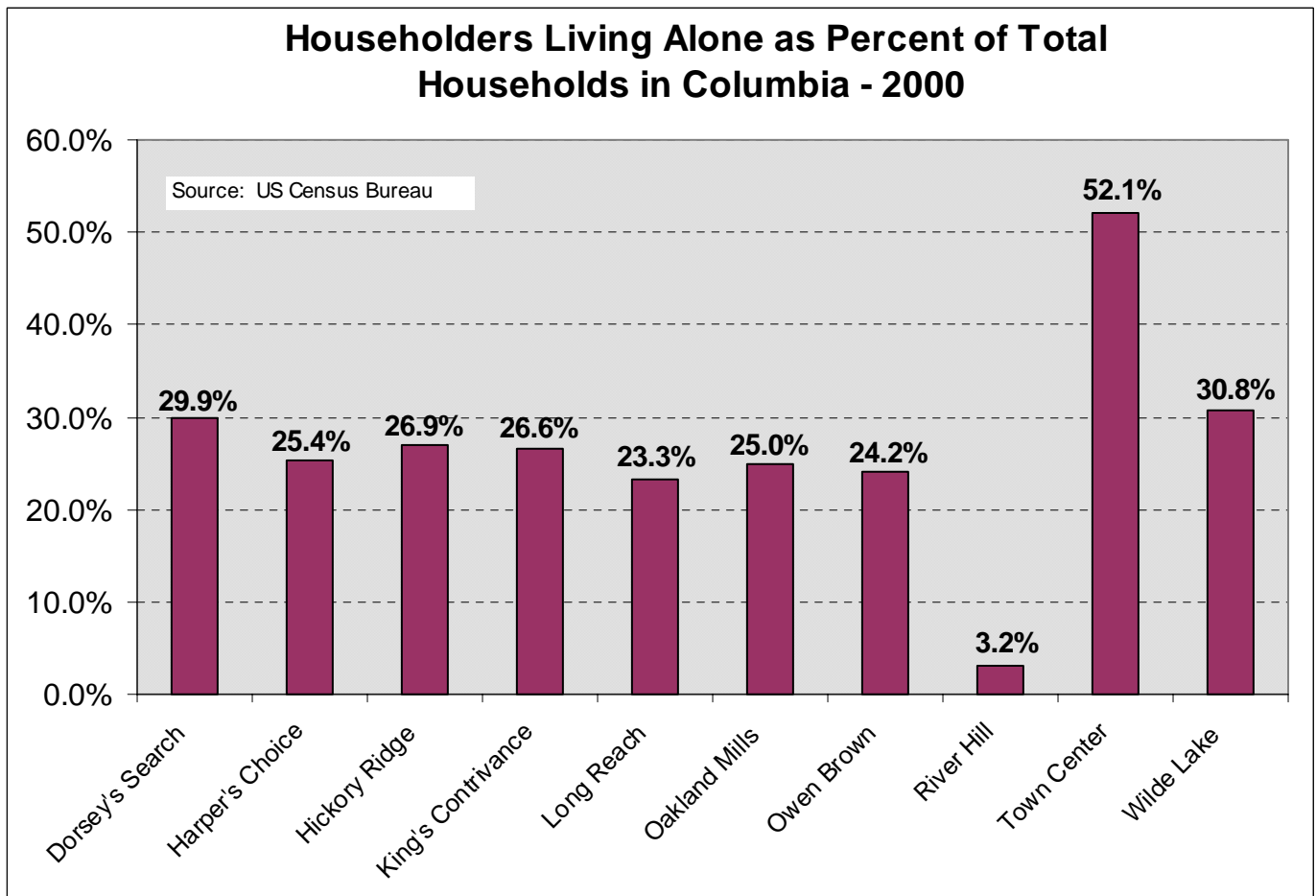

Housing Unit Tenure and Vacancies

The tables below summarize the housing unit tenure and vacancy status for each of the villages in Columbia. Of the total 35,974 housing units in Columbia, about 64 percent are owner occupied and 33 percent renter occupied. A little over 3.3 percent were vacant in 2000. River Hill by far has the greatest percentage of owner occupied units at close to 97 percent.⁷ This is followed by Long Reach with 69.7 percent and then Owen Brown with 69.5 percent. The villages with the greatest percentage of renter occupied units include Hickory Ridge (40.2 percent), Oakland Mills (38.5 percent), and then Dorsey's Search (37.3 percent). Harper's Choice (37.1 percent), King's Contrivance (35.1 percent) and Town Center (36.0 percent) also have relatively high percentages of renter occupied units.

Town Center had the highest vacancy rate in 2000 at 8.8 percent, a full 5.5 percent higher than the Columbia average. Dorsey's Search had a relatively high vacancy rate as well at 5.2 percent, followed by Wilde Lake at 4.2 percent. These results are shown graphically in the chart on the next page.

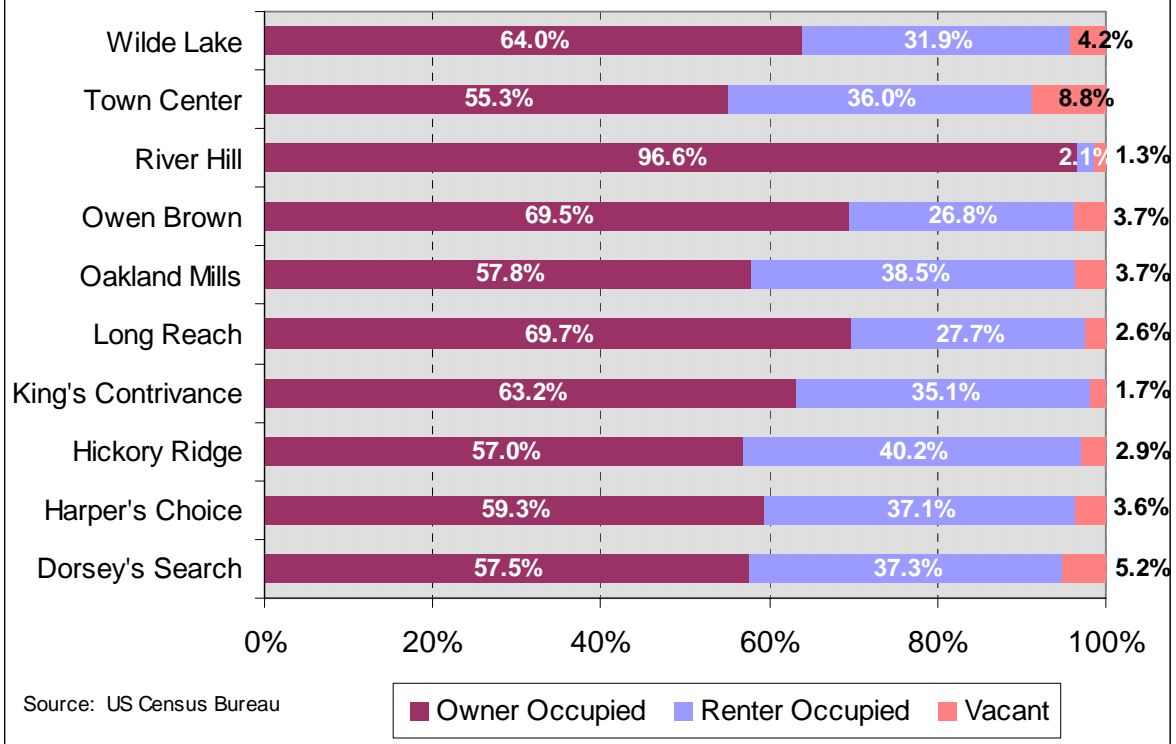

Percent of Housing Units By Tenure and Occupancy Columbia - 2000

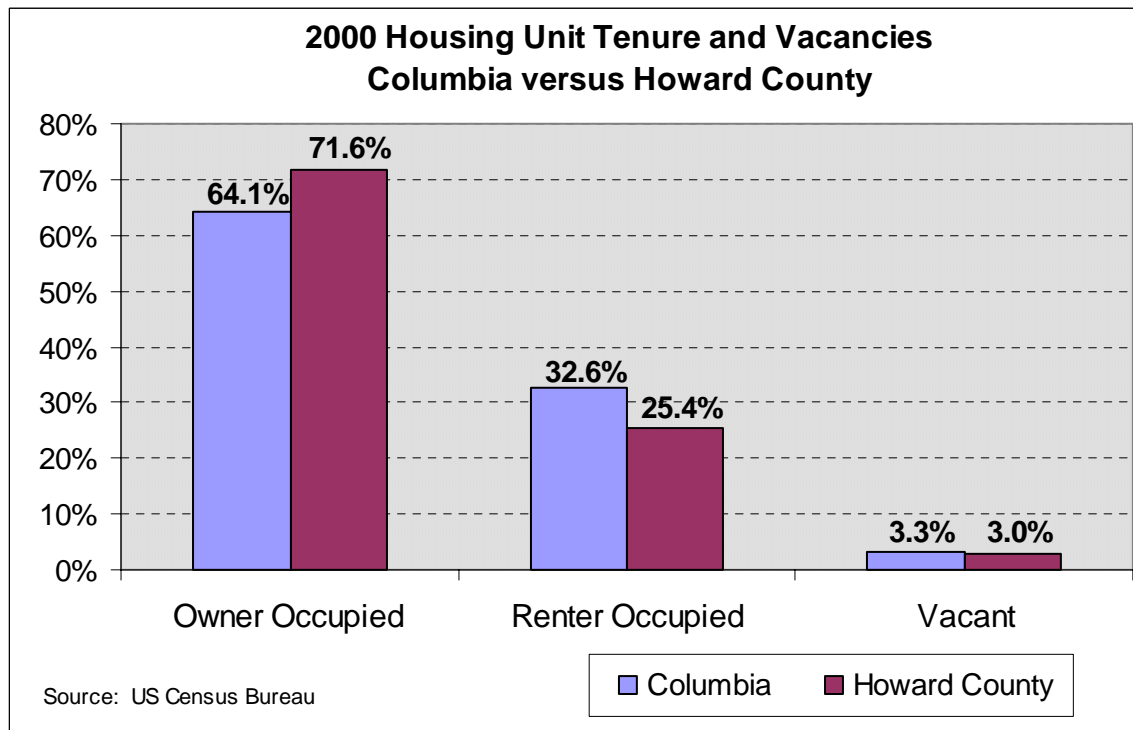


Compared to Howard County as a whole, Columbia has a higher ratio of renter occupied units – one out of every 3 units compared to one out of every 4 units in the County. This reflects Columbia’s relatively high numbers of apartment units in most village cores. In fact, in 2000 almost half of the renter occupied units in Howard County were located in Columbia, despite the fact that Columbia only had 38.8 percent of the total units in the County. In 2000, the vacancy rates were similar between the County and Columbia, with Columbia being only slightly greater. The chart on the following page summarizes these results graphically.

The tables below summarize the age of householder for renter and owner occupied units for each of the villages. Highlights include:

- Of all *owner occupied* housing units in Columbia, 47.2 percent of householders are between the ages of 45 and 64, 42.0 percent between 25 and 44, 9.9 percent 65 and older, and 0.6 percent between 15 and 24. Some exceptions to this norm include Wilde Lake where 25.6 percent of the householders of owner occupied units are 65 and older. This is closely followed by Town Center with 25.0 percent 65 and older. Harper’s Choice has 15.6 percent 65 and older and Oakland Mills has 13.0 percent 65 and older.
- Of all *renter occupied* housing units in Columbia, 59.6 percent of householders are between the ages of 25 to 44, 20.6 percent between 45 and 64, 11.4 percent 65 and older, and 8.4 percent between 15 and 24. Some exceptions to this norm include Town Center where 31.6 percent of all renter occupied housing units have householders 65 and older. This is followed by Owen Brown with 26.9 percent.

The chart following the tables shows renter occupied housing units as a percent of *all housing units* by age of householder. This chart shows, for example, that over 90 percent of householders age 15 to 24 rent as opposed to own in Dorsey’s Search, King’s Contrivance, Hickory Ridge and Oakland Mills. In general, the next biggest group of renters are householders 65 and older. This ranges from 12 percent in River Hill to 60 percent in Owen Brown.

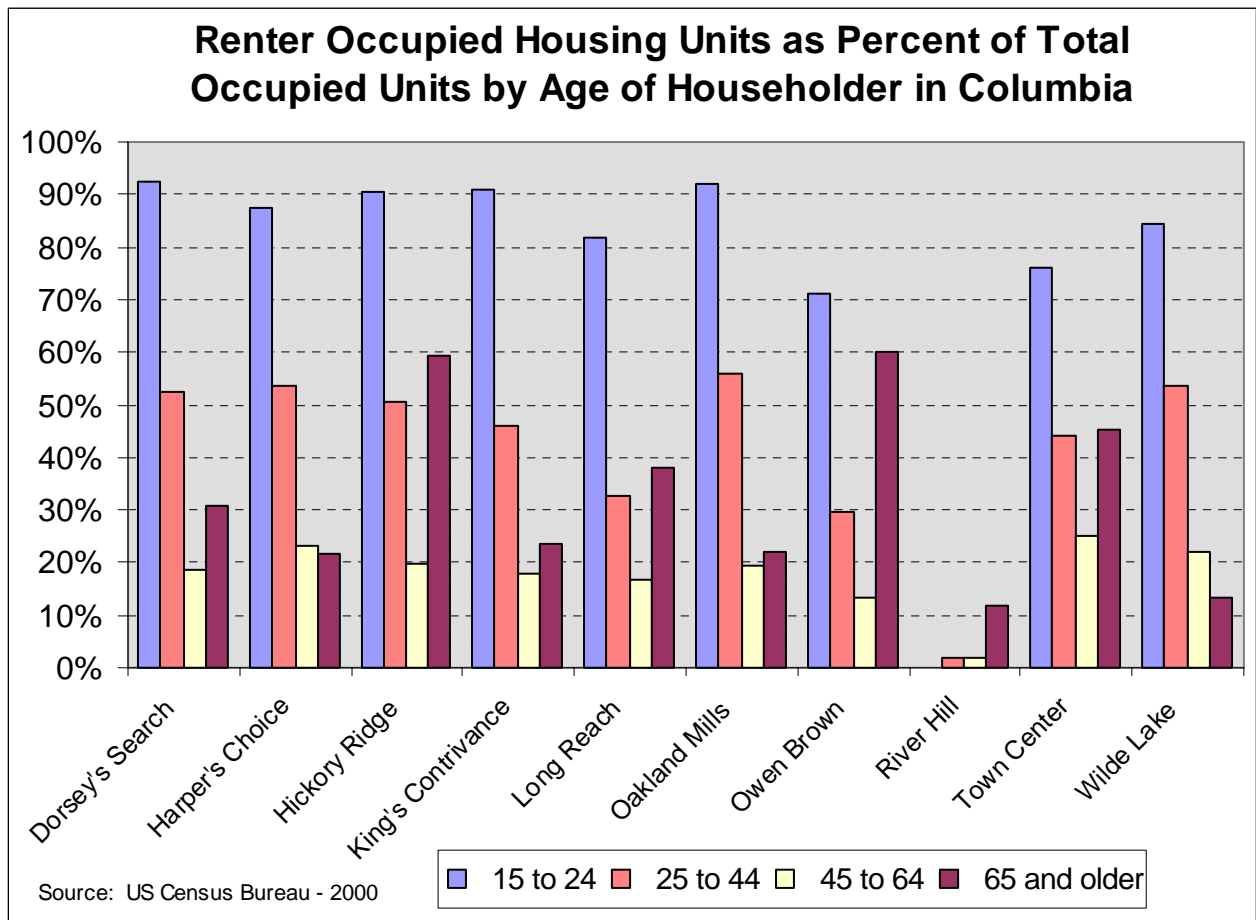

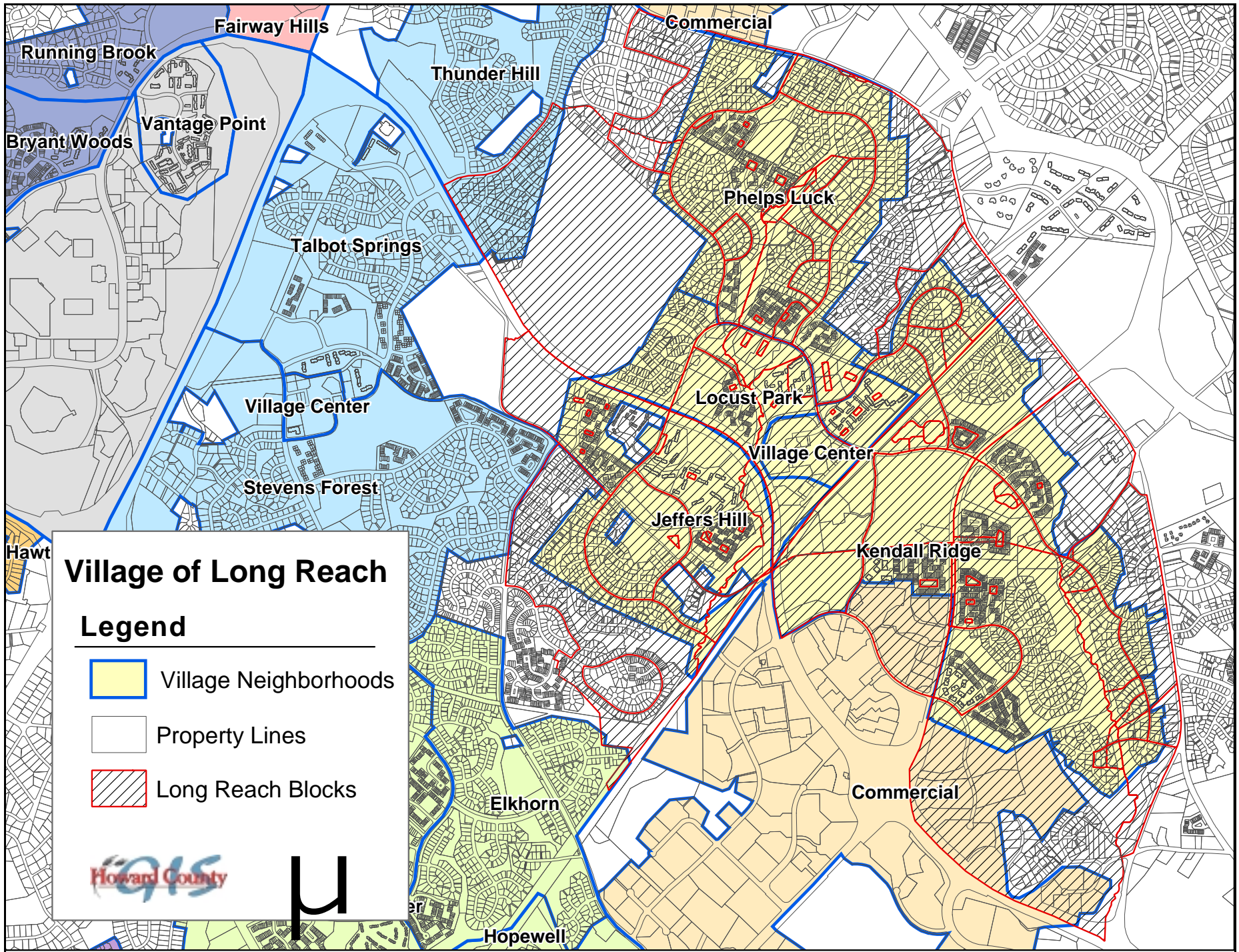
Maps of Columbia Villages Showing Best Fit of Census Blocks

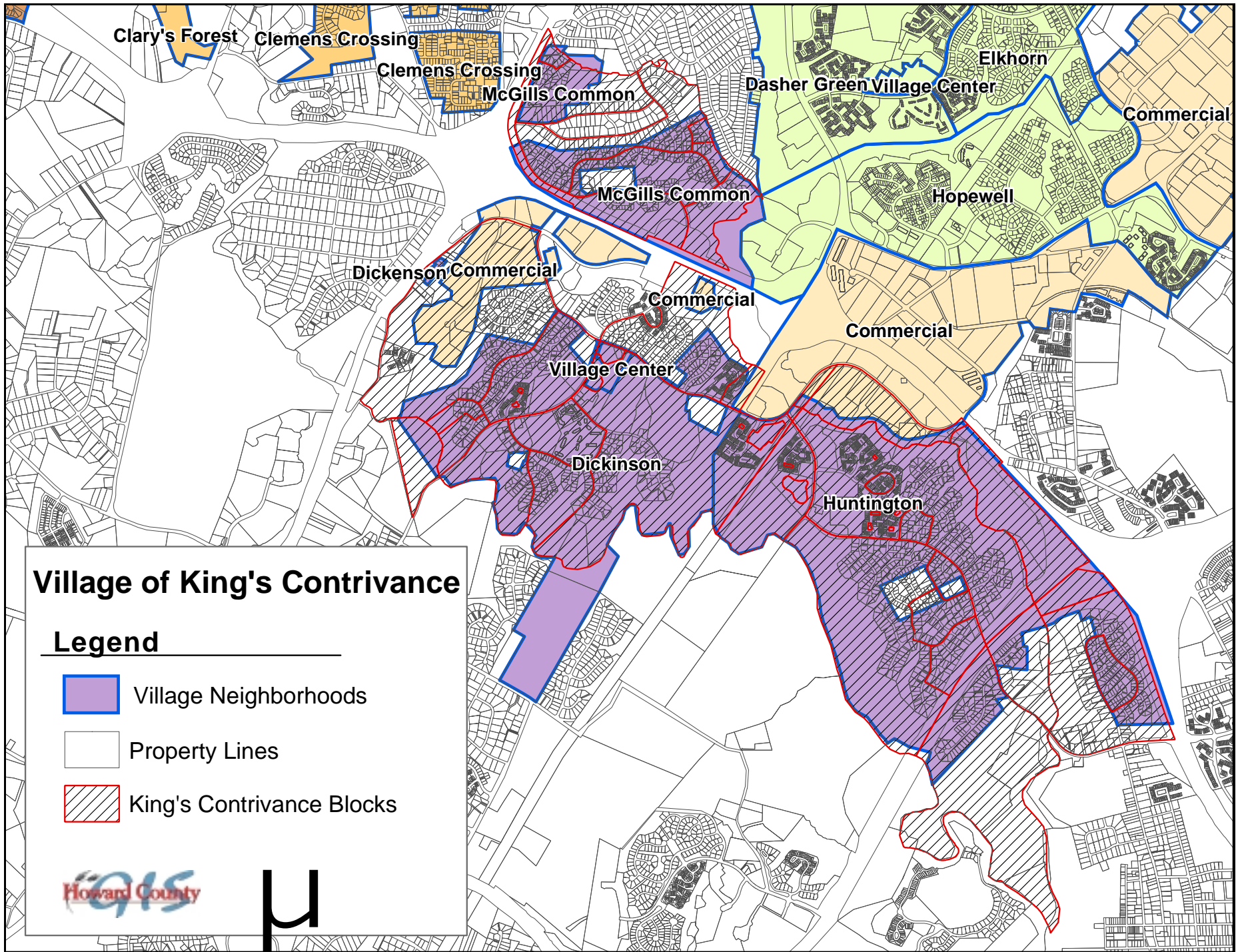
