FOR the purpose of requiring that, beginning with a certain election, certain members of 4 5 the Howard County Board of Education be elected by districts and certain members 6 be elected at large; providing that a member elected to the county board from a 7 certain geographic area but whose district boundaries are subsequently altered may 8 remain as a member of the county board for a certain period; providing that in 9 making an appointment to fill a vacancy on the county board the County Executive 10 of Howard County shall endeavor to ensure that the county board reflects certain 11 characteristics of the county population; providing for the termination of the terms 12 of certain members of the county board; providing for the application of this Act; and 13 generally relating to the election of the members of the Howard County Board of Education. 14
