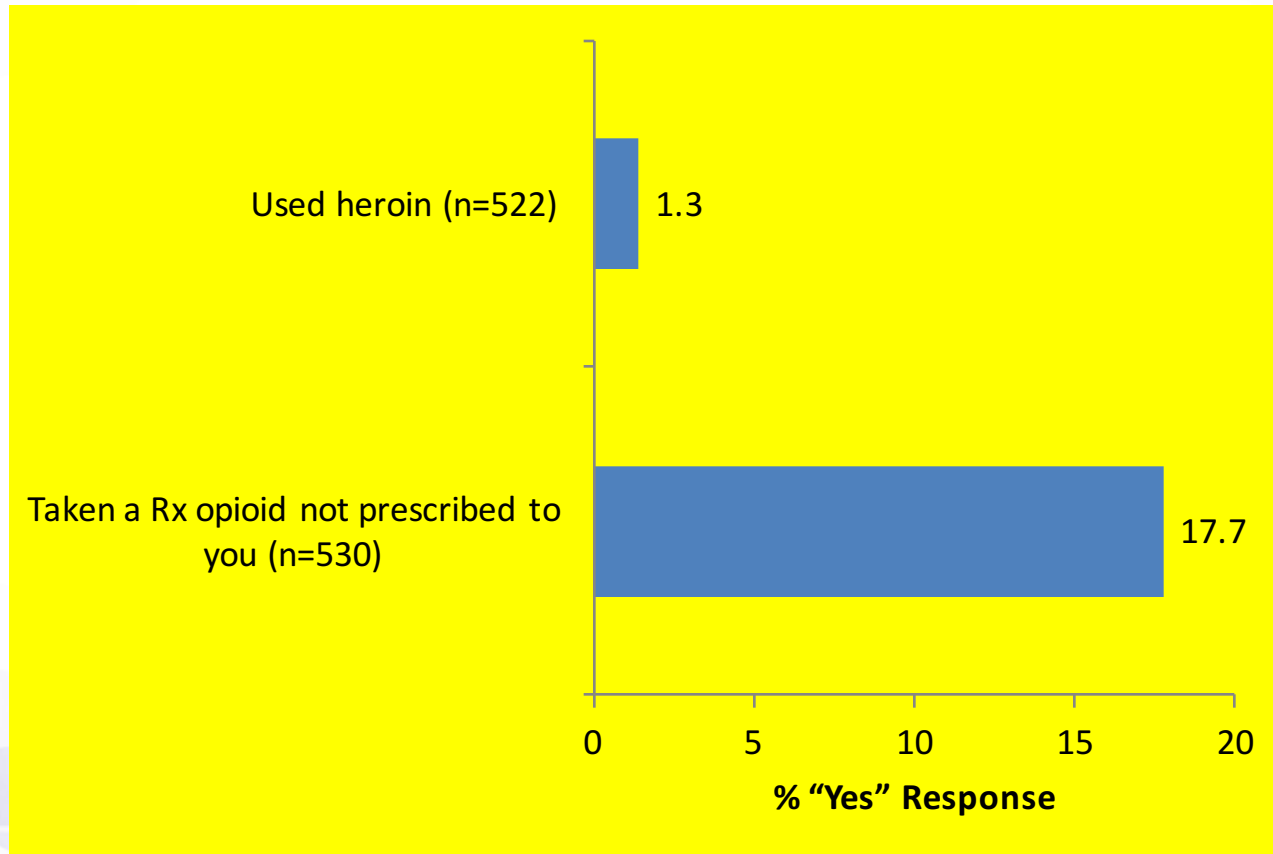

Maryland Public Opinion Survey on Opioids, 2016-17

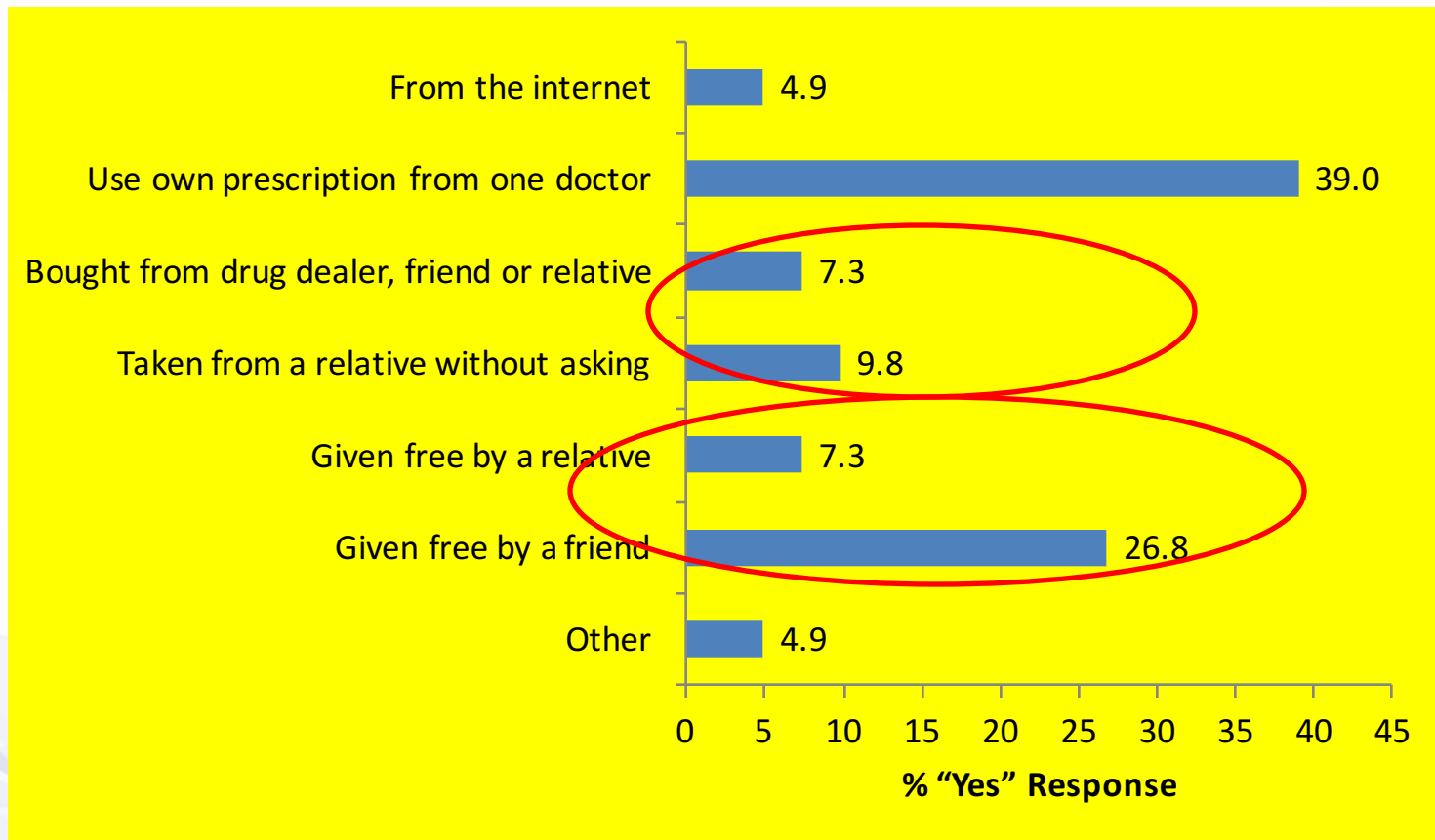
In your lifetime, have you ever...

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How did you get your last Rx opioid? (n=41)



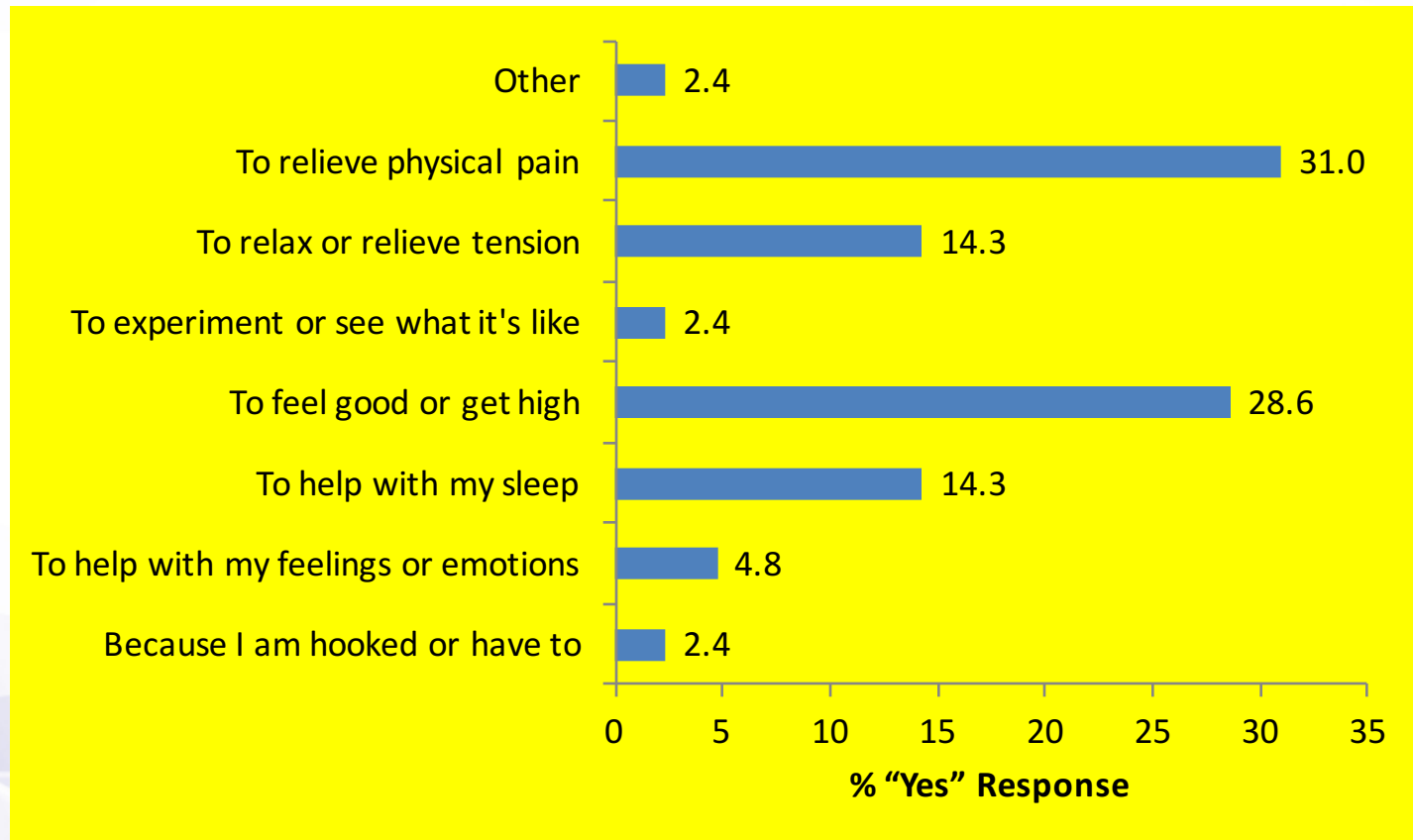

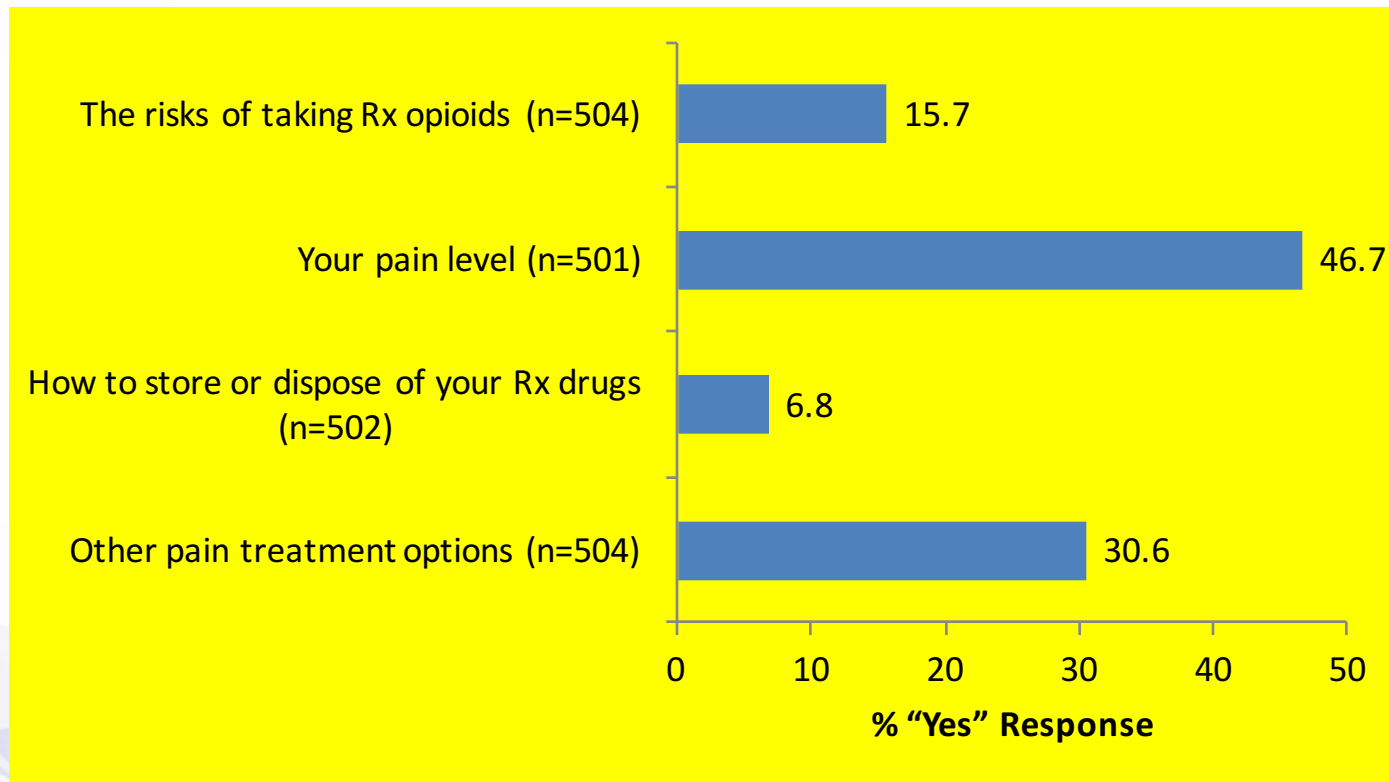
**Why you took an unprescribed opioid/Rx opioid that was not prescribed to you? (n=42)**



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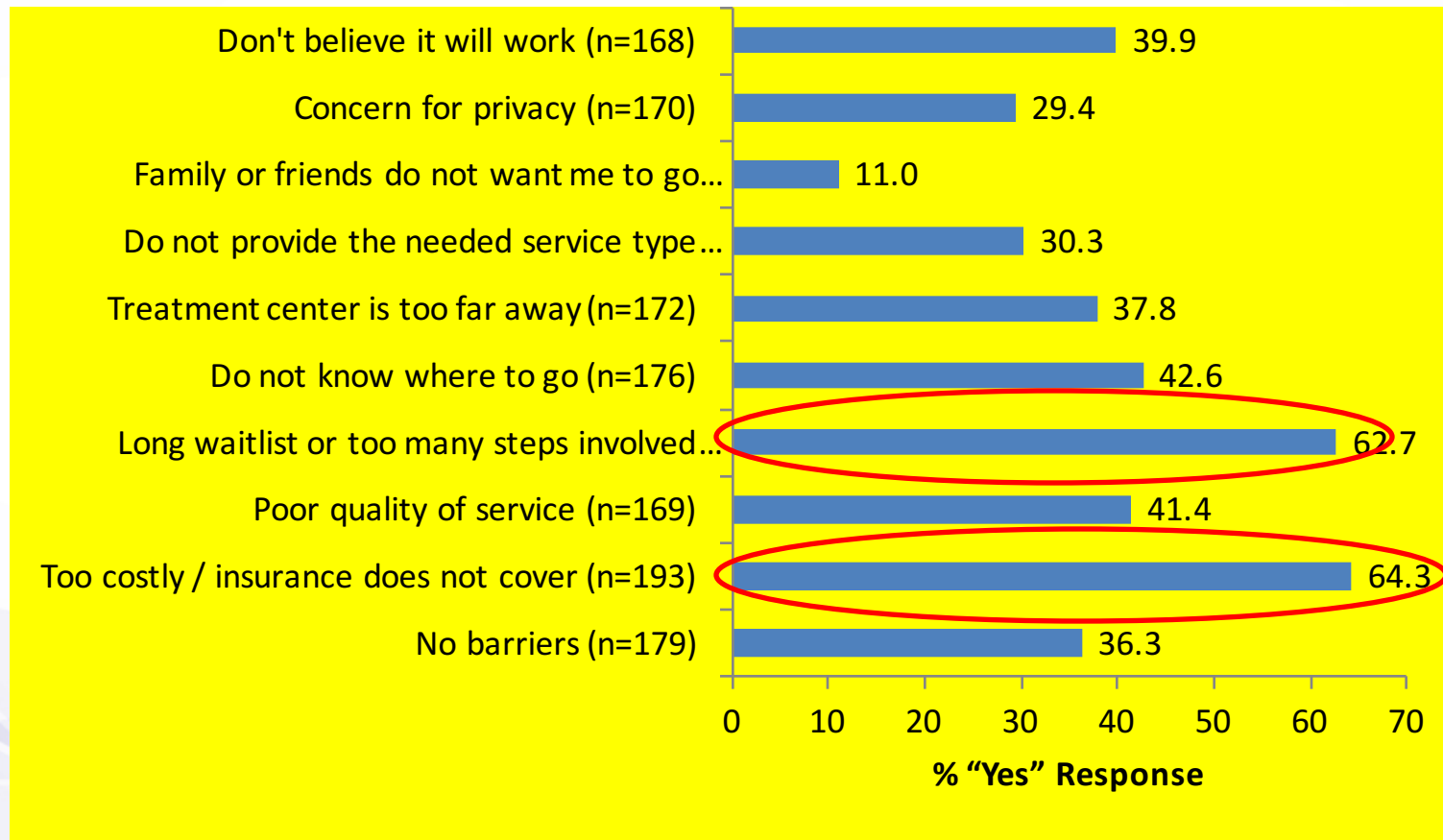

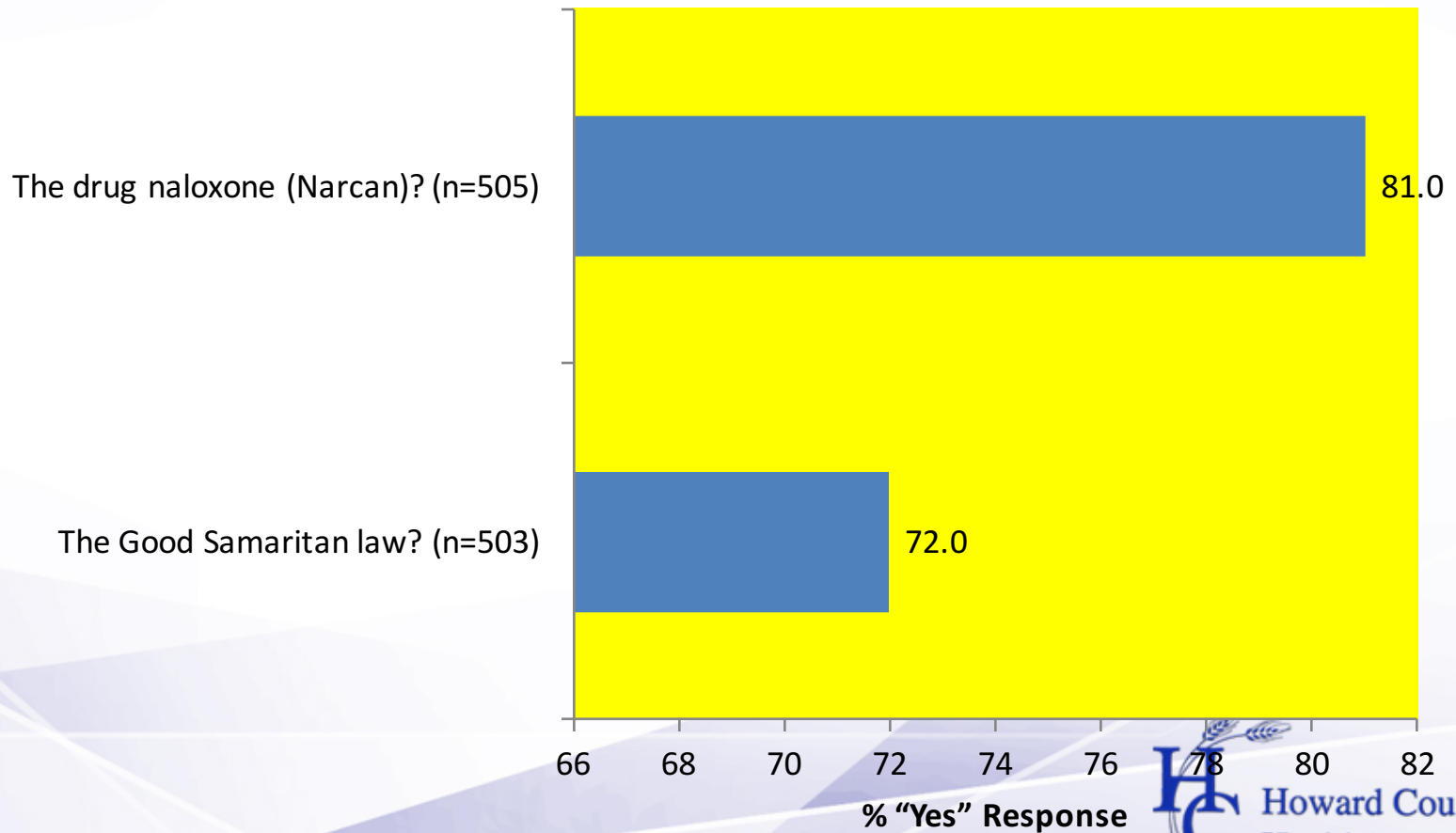

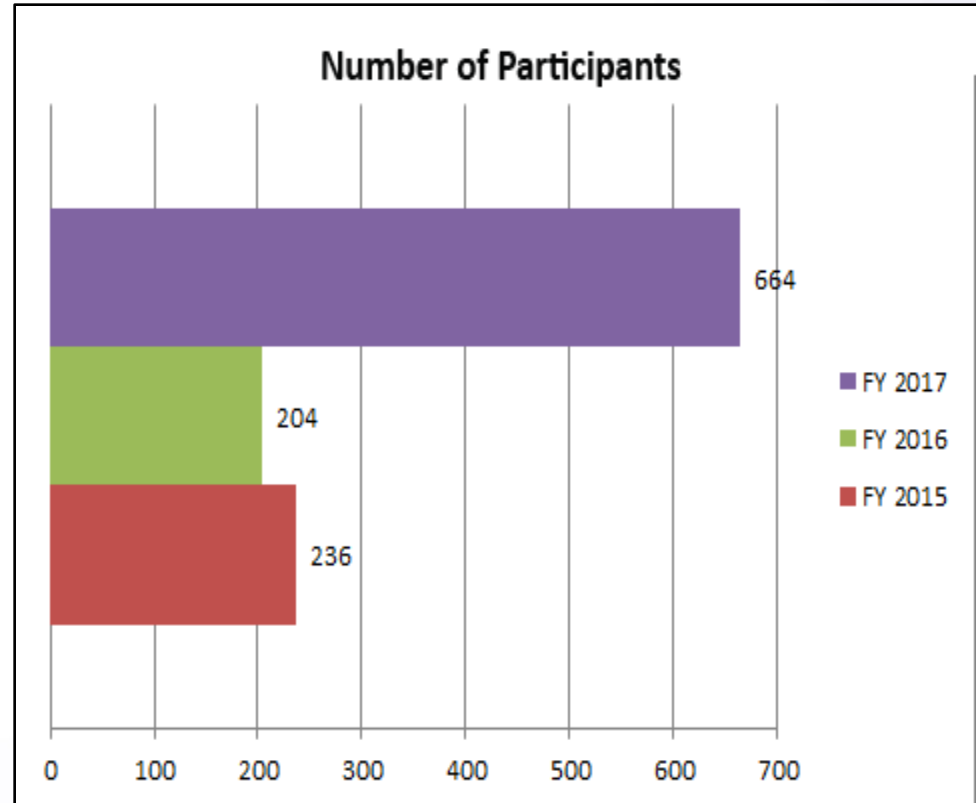
