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- 2 (d) (1) The [chairman] CHAIR and other elected board members may 3 participate in health insurance and other benefit programs sponsored by the board.
- 4 (2) An elected board member's participation in a benefit program 5 sponsored by the board under this subsection may not be considered compensation for the 6 purpose of calculating compensation under subsection (a) of this section.
- 7 (e) (1) (i) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall 8 be entitled to a scholarship of \$5,000 to be applied to the student's higher education costs.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the chair and members of the Howard County Board of Education while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the chair and members of the Howard County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
