


Safeguarding Houses of Worship

Instructions for installing the National Institute of Justice app on your phone

Installing the app on your iOS device:

You will need a download code from the police department to install the app on an Apple device. To download Safeguarding Houses of Worship, open the App Store and log in using your iTunes account information. Toward the bottom of the "Favorites" screen will be a button marked "Redeem." Click on it and you will be prompted to enter a code. This is where you will enter the download code. You will not be able to find Safeguarding Houses of Worship as an app if you search for it in the App Store, as we are using this download code to help us vet who receives the app. Only one download will be possible per code; contact HCPD for codes for additional devices, or if you did not receive one.



Installing the app on your Android device:

Due to the potential for using the Safeguarding Houses of Worship app to gather and store potentially sensitive information about your facility, it is not publically available on the Google Play Marketplace. To install the app on your device, you will need to enable the Unknown Sources feature. To turn on Unknown Sources, follow the directions on screen when opening the Safeguarding Houses of Worship.apk file or go to **Settings**, select **Lock screen and security** or **Security**, check or turn on **Unknown sources**. Obtain the necessary URL by contacting the police department. This URL is only for authorized party download and use. Do not distribute this web page to any outside parties.

Note: The device on which this app is installed must be kept secure at all times in order to ensure that unauthorized parties do not gain access to the information you have stored on the app itself.
