

## **Interactive Map: Find my Zoning Tutorial**

1. Open the Howard Count data download and viewer page: <u>https://data.howardcountymd.gov/</u>

This is the same mapping application that you used in the first exercise. We encourage you to explore the site for additional resources of interest.

2. Click on "My Neighborhood"
