- I. The meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m.
- II. The agenda was approved unanimously with changes to the Employee Speak-Out placement in agenda.
- III. The minutes from meeting held on May 7, 2019 were approved unanimously as presented.
- IV. No employees participated in the Speak-Out.
- V. Ms. Stacey Simmons presented Pay Plan changes of a 2% salary scale adjustment for Police and an additional 3% for 27 years longevity pay added to Sheriff as a result of negotiated agreements. Also presented were Class Plan changes for Police Officers and Sheriff Deputies. The updates pertain to minimum education and experience, required

- licenses, certificates and/or registrations, and class descriptions. The Personnel Board reviewed, voted and approved changes.
- VI. During a second Employee Speak-Out portion an employee asked about a county-wide salary scales survey comparing Howard County to other counties which had been discussed years before. Ms. Wanda Hutchinson, Human Resources Administrator addressed the question explaining that while important, this project has not been approved in budgetary funding since recognized as a goal.
