- 7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not issue

- 9 **ELECTION DISTRICT**, as determined by the latest federal census.
- 10 (b) This section does not apply to a Class A license issued for use in an existing
- shopping center or in a proposed shopping center development for which a building permit
- 12 has been issued that contains 200,000 or more square feet of commercial retail space.
