Approval of Minutes

Rescheduling of Public Hearing

Presentations

While there were no formal presentations, Dani Phillips from Howard County's Office of Community Sustainability presented a summary of answers to various questions that task force members provided in writing individually. The questions were focused on incentives for solar in the County as well as updates to zoning regulations. Members discussed incentives versus mandates for solar installations, as well as incentivizing pollinator habitats or farming under solar. Members were in agreement that there should be minimal to no limitations on rooftop solar arrays in any zoning district. Howard County's Department of Planning and Zoning would like to allow for a solar installation where more than 50% of the power is used off-site, as they have received these types of requests in the past (i.e. aggregated net metering). Members agreed that this should be allowed for rooftop installations. Corey Ramsden suggested looking into the 2018 International Green Construction Code for ideas on zoning regulations. There were also suggestions that the solar zoning definitions should be amended to have a clear distinction between 1) ground-mount and rooftop solar arrays and 2) residential and non-residential zoning districts.
