POLICY: The Howard County Department of Correction shall comply with the registration requirements pertaining to certain qualified convicted sex offenders as defined in Maryland Criminal Procedure Articles §11-701.

REFERENCES Maryland Criminal Procedure Articles §11-701; HCDC Policy C-203 Release Procedures; B-105 Escape Procedures; K-101 Receiving Detainees and Policy K-110 Commitments, Transfers and Releases.

DEFINITIONS:

<u>Registrant</u>: Anyone who is convicted of any of the qualifying offenses listed on the Registration Scheme under Maryland SORNA, attached as Appendix 1.

MOSOR: Maryland Online Sex Offender Registry (Toll Free Phone Number 1-866-559-8017).

COMET: Collaborative Offender Management/Enforced Treatment.

Release: Any type of release from Howard County Department of Corrections' custody. "Release" includes parole, mandatory supervision, work release, and any type of temporary leave that is granted on an emergency basis. For the purpose of this policy "release" does not include an escape.

PROCEDURES:

I. General Information

A. The Howard County Department of Corrections cooperates with the Howard County Police Department, the States Attorney's Office and the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to ensure all sex offender registration requirements are met. The HCDC promotes sound management of sex offenders through active participation in COMET.

- B. Howard County Department of Corrections has specific responsibilities for registration of sex offenders. The Director has designated a Sex Offender Liaison, (SOL) to ensure that Department requirements are properly met.
- C. The Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services is the agency responsible for maintaining a statewide registry of sex offenders.
- D. A complete registration packet shall include:
 - 1. Fingerprint card with a Pre-Printed bar code, CJIS Form 006, Green and White, "8 X 8", attached as Appendix #2; and photograph; or the electronic version of same, which can be obtained with Live Scan.
 - 2. Maryland Online Sex Offender Registration Form; CJIS Form 16A, attached as Appendix # 3.
 - 3. Maryland Notice of Sexual Offender Registration Requirements Form; CJIS Form 16C, attached as Appendix # 4.

II. <u>Initial Identification and Registration</u>

Upon receipt of a sentencing commitment, the Commitment Officer shall review Appendix # 1, to determine if the inmate has been convicted of a qualifying offense.

- A. If convicted of a qualifying offense, the Commitment Officer shall:
 - 1. Stamp the cover of the inmate basefile with the "SOR" stamp.
 - 2. Notify by email, the Sex Offender Liaison and/or Designee, as well as the Classification Supervisor, Chief of Security, Deputy Director, and Director. Include in the email the inmate name and HCDC ID number, as well as the qualifying offense and sentence.
- B. The Sex Offender Liaison/Designee shall review the commitment to determine if the conviction requires registration. Officials of the Court and MOSOR staff may be contacted for clarification or assistance. The contact phone number for the Sex Offender Registry Unit is 410-585-3600 or 410-585-3649.
- C. If it is determined that the inmate does not require registration, the Sex Offender Liaison/designee, shall enter an alert on JMS; "Sex Offender Registration not required"; and strike through, initial, and date the SOR stamp on the cover of the basefile.
- D. If it is determined that the inmate requires registration, the Sex Offender Liaison/designee shall:
 - 1. Enter an alert on JMS "Sex Offender Registration required."
 - 2. Interview the inmate and following MOSOR guidelines and procedures, register the inmate providing as much detail as available.

- 3. Complete, print, and have the inmate sign a Maryland Online Sex Offender Registration (Appendix 3) and Notice of Sex Offender Registration Requirements (Appendix 4); placing the signed originals in the basefile. The inmate shall be given a copy of Appendix 4.
- 4 Notify Howard County Police, Sex Offender Unit, Detective Robert Rodriguez by phone (410-313-3331) or email (rrodriguez@howardcountymd.gov) and/or Detective Christopher Kolb (410-313-2697) or (Ckolb@howardcountymd.gov) advising that a new registrant has been placed in their electronic MOSOR folder, and it awaits their review, copy the Director on this email.
 - a. Include in email and telephone communication to HCPD, inmate's full name, Tier classification (shown in Appendix 1), and home address including County.
 - b. Include in email and telephone communication reference any "default" or "unknown" fields that may need their corrective action, if known.
 - c. The notification shall be documented in the inmate's basefile.

III. General Procedures upon Release of a Registrant

- A. Upon the release of any inmate, other than Work Release, the Shift Leader must determine, prior to release, whether the inmate is a registrant by checking the intake basefile to determine if there is a registered sex offender warning notice in place from the warrant check or an Appendix 4, in the basefile.
 - 1. If the basefile indicates that the inmate to be released is a registrant, the Shift Supervisor must complete the following:
 - a. Notify the inmate of his obligation to register as a registrant. Notification to the inmate shall be given by completing the Howard County Notice of Registration Requirement HCDC Form A-031a, attached as Appendix 5. The signed original remains in the basefile, and a copy is given to the Inmate.
 - b. If the inmate is a Howard County resident, notify Howard County Police Sex Offender Unit Detective Robert Rodriguez by phone (410-313-3331) or email (rrodriguez@howardcountymd.gov) and/or Detective Christopher Kolb (410-313-2697) or (Ckolb@howardcountymd.gov)
 - c. If the inmate is a resident of another county or state notify the local law enforcement agency via email and telephone, using "Local Law Enforcement Contact List" attached as Appendix 6 or "State/Territory Sex Offender Registry agencies "attached as Appendix 7 (updates to these lists shall be maintained in the Commitment Office and by the Sex Offender Liaison/designee) of the release of the request. This shall be documented in the inmate's basefile.

- d. Notify the Sex Offender Liaison, Classification Supervisor, Security Chief, Deputy Director and Director via email.
- B. For guidance on release of arrestees from Central Booking Facility see HCDC Policy K-110 Commitments, Transfers and Releases.

C. Work Release Assignment

- 1. Participation in a work release program constitutes the "release" of an inmate for purposes of the notification requirements of Criminal Procedure Articles §11-701-715.
- 2. Prior to approving the participation of any inmate in a Work Release Program, the Work Release Coordinator shall determine whether the inmate is a registrant by checking the basefile for a completed Appendix 4 and/or if a warning notice from the warrant check that identifies the offender as a registered sex offender.
 - a. If the inmate is a registrant, the Work Release Coordinator shall ensure the registrant's employment/school information is updated on MOSOR before the inmate is placed on active work release status: and
 - b. Shall wait for MOSOR update confirmation prior to first day of work.

IV. Notification of Escape or Death of a Registrant

- A. In the event of the death of an inmate Registrant while in our custody, notification shall be made to the Maryland Sex Offender Registry by email at (soru.registration@atmaryland.gov) and (allison.gilford@maryland.gov) and telephone 410-585-3649 by the Shift Leader as soon as practical.
- B. In the event of the escape of an inmate Registrant, a prompt phone call shall be made to the Maryland Sex Offender Registry during business hours at 410-585-3649, followed up by an email by the Shift Leader as soon as practical.

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

Definitions for the Notice of Sex Offender Registration Requirements

"Habitually Lives" means a place or location where a registrant lives, sleeps, or visits with any regularity, including where a homeless person is stationed during the day or sleeps at night. "Habitually Lives" includes any place where a person visits for longer than 5 hours per visit more than 5 times within a 30 day period. **Criminal Procedure Article**, § 11-701(f)

"Homeless" means having no fixed residence. Criminal Procedure Article, § 11-701(g)

"Jurisdiction" means a State or Native American Tribe that elects to function as a registration jurisdiction under Federal law. *Criminal Procedure Article*, § 11-701(i)

"Local Law Enforcement Unit" means the law enforcement unit in a county that has been designated by resolution of the county governing body as the primary law enforcement unit in the county. Criminal Procedure Article, § 11-701(i)

"Primary Registration Agency" means the local law enforcement unit that conducts a registrant's periodic registration and is responsible for maintaining a registrant's registration statement information. COMAR 12.06.01.02(25)
