Howard County Legislation Prohibiting Parking in Bike Lanes

- Council Bill 49-2020
- Introduced 9/8/2020
- Public Hearing 9/21/20
- Council Vote 10/5/20
- Defines "bike lane"
- Prohibits parking in a bike lane
- Council Resolution 138-2020 sets fine at \$33
- Vehicle can also be impounded

Bike Lane Striping Projects

- North Ridge Road from Route 40 to Town and Country Blvd
 - ➤ Held public meeting on June 30, 2020
 - Marking is being scheduled by DPW Traffic Engineering
- Marshalee Drive from Montgomery Rd/Shady Oak Lane to Gatepost Way
 - Held public meeting on June 31, 2020
 - Marking is being scheduled by DPW Traffic Engineering
 - Also needs a spot patch in shoulder
- Vollmerhausen Road from Guilford Road to Savage Guilford Road
 - ➤ Waiting for date for public meeting with Savage Community Association
- Deerpath Road and Douglas Legum Drive
 - Completed
- Rivendell Lane from Harpers Farm Road to Cedar Lane
 - Completed (also sharrows on Cedar Lane from Rivendell Lane to MD108)
- White Acre Road from Stevens Forest Road to Basket Ring Road
 - Completed as part of White Acre Road Complete Streets Improvements

Shared Use Pathway Completion

Twin Rivers Pathway from Governor Warfield Parkway to Faulker Ridge Circle

- Built by Howard Hughes as a development requirement
- Also includes several crossing improvements






- New pedestrian crossing across Cedar Lane at the end of the Downtown Columbia Trail

Business from Last Meeting

- Grist Mill Trail Wash Outs
 - MD Department of Natural Resources is working on a design.
 Not expected to be built until 2021 or later
- Dorsey Road (MD 103) Resurfacing
 - MD State Highway Administration evaluated and there was not enough available width for existing travel lanes plus bike lanes
- Bike Access to Dorsey MARC Train Station from Deerpath Road
 - MD Transit Authority is evaluating
